**Annual Information Meeting (AIM)** – The Joint Services Committee, of which one member of each Summer Village sits, passed a decision to refrain from having Administration host any AIMs on a moving forward basis. If an individual Summer Village chooses to hold an AIM, it can be done so on their own without any time commitment of administrative staff. This decision, mutually agreed upon by all five Summer Villages will allow Administration to continue efficiencies and better serve all municipalities.

**Waste Disposal Contract** – The waste disposal contractor has recently changed to Empringham Disposal. Garbage pick-up remains every Monday with refuse needing to be out before 7:00am to ensure service. Please keep all garbage in a receptacle with a tight-fitting lid, in addition please pick up any litter around your property to keep the neighbourhood clean.

**NEW 3-Way Stop** – A 3-way stop has been installed at the intersection of Jarvis Bay Drive and Jarvis Glen Way. With limited visibility at this corner the goal is to make this intersection safer for drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians.

**Highway 20 Speed Limit** – In early May, the Summer Village of Jarvis Bay met with the Minister of Transportation, the Honourable Rajan Sawhney to discuss lowering the speed limit on Highway 20. Resulting from that meeting a Ministerial Order was granted to lower the speed limit. The Order will be enacted this summer with new signs being erected and a period of education for all drivers. The affected area will be from Township Road 39-2 south to the traffic circle on Highway 11A at the entrance to the Town of Sylvan Lake. Thank you to all the residents who supported this goal and helped Council and Administration to achieve it!

**Neighbourly News** – The Jarvis Bay Provincial Park has opened a new store this year named the “Owl’s Nest”. This store is located just past the check-in booth, right next to the playground and offers hard ice cream, snacks, and camping supplies. It is open Monday to Thursday from 12:30pm to 8:30pm, Friday and Saturday from 1:00pm to 9:00pm.
