

**SUMMER VILLAGE OF SUNBREAKER COVE
BY-LAW #103-14**

A By-law of the Summer Village of Sunbreaker Cove in the Province of Alberta to amend By-law 99-13, the Land Use By-law, to establish penalties for contravention of the by-law.

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Sunbreaker Cove deems it to be expedient and proper to amend the Land Use By-law 99-13;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Sunbreaker Cove in open Council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Schedule D shall be included by as follow:

Offence	Minimum Specified Penalty First Offence
Fail to Obtain a Development Permit	\$1,500.00
Fail to comply with Development Permit / Development Permit Conditions	\$1,500.00
Failure to contain construction materials / refuse	\$1,500.00
Display unapproved advertising signage	\$1,500.00
Failure to comply with rules for temporary signs	\$1,500.00

2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect on the day it is passed.
