Summer Village of Birchcliff 2023 Mill Rate Bylaw No. #242-23

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF BIRCHCLIFF FOR THE 2023 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Summer Village of Birchcliff has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of municipal revenue, expenses and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on April 20, 2023.

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues and transfer from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$361,132.40 and the balance of \$370,712.29 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenses (excluding non-cash items) set out in the annual budget for the Summer Village of Birchcliff for 2023 total \$731,844.69; and

THEREFORE, the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$370,712.29 and

WHEREAS, the requisitions are estimated to be:

WHEREAS, the council is authorized to sub-classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each sub-class of property, subject to the *Municipal Government Act,* Chapter M-26, Revised Statues of Alberta, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of all property in the Summer Village of Birchcliff as shown on the assessment roll is:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of the Summer Village of Birchcliff:
