Rules Regarding Delegations

In accordance with Bylaw #268-22, Rules of Procedure, a by-law to provide rules for governing the order and procedures of the Council of the Summer Village of Norglenwold:

- Delegations may only address Council or Committee with respect to an item on the agenda and verbally present information on matter of fact.
- In order to be included as a delegation on the public agenda, Delegates must submit to the Summer Village Office, a written request to appear no later than 10 days before the scheduled day of the meeting, including a written outline of the comments to be made at the meeting. Delegation requests received after this time will not be listed on the public agenda, but at the discretion of the CAO, may be granted permission to speak in front of Council or the appropriate Committee.
- There is a strict time limit for delegations at meetings. Delegations will have 10 minutes for their
 presentation, not inclusive of questions from Council or the Committee, unless the Chair, at their
 discretion, agrees to extend the time.
- PowerPoint presentations are permitted provided that an electronic copy of the presentation is submitted to the Summer Village Office no later than 10 days before the scheduled meeting. A copy may be distributed to Members of Council, or Committee as the case may be, as part of the delegation submission.

If your delegation request does not meet the requirements of Procedural By-law #268-22 and therefore denied, you may contact your local Summer Village of Norglenwold Councillor and they may wish to request the item from the Council Information Section
