WASTEWATER UTILITY BILL SURVEY RESULTS

Council discussed the results that came back from residents about the wastewater utility bill survey that was mailed to residents and posted on the webpage. Majority of the respondents were in favor of Council transferring money from reserves to cover the cost.

OPERATING BUDGET

The 2019 -2022 Operating Budget was presented with requested amendments made from the November meeting. Council decided to table the 2019-2022 Operating Budget until after the Capital Budget.

FEES BYLAW

Council discussed comments received at the Public Hearing regarding the Fees Bylaw #244-18. Second reading of the Fees Bylaw #244-18 was given by Mayor Ludwig. Council table third reading until next meeting for further consideration.
