



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Council adopted the 2025 Audited Financial Statements as presented by the Metrix Group.

ANNUAL INFORMATION MEETING

Council chose June 27, 2026, to hold their Annual Information Meeting. The meeting will be held at the Administration Office commencing at 10:00 a.m.

LAND USE BYLAW PUBLIC HEARING

Council discussed dates for the Land Use Bylaw Public Hearing. To ensure all residents have an opportunity to attend, the meeting will be held in the evening on Monday, July 27, 2026, commencing at 6:30 p.m. Further information will be sent to each residence closer to this date. GROUNDWATER LITERATURE REVIEW

Jarvis Bay, in collaboration with the other 4 summer villages, has hired a third party to help build a strategy that will guide the work required to ensure that the summer villages have safe drinking water and the watershed is protected into the future. Council agreed to contribute \$7,359 for Jarvis Bay's portion of the study.

2026 MILL RATE BYLAW

Council reviewed and passed the 2026 Mill Rate Bylaw. Tax/Assessment notices will be mailed out on Friday, May 22, 2026, and all taxes are due by **July 31, 2026**. Please ensure your mailing address is current with the office. If you have not received your tax notice by June 5, 2026, please contact the office.

ROAD RIGHT OF WAY MAINTENANCE POLICY

This item was tabled until the May 5, 2026, meeting for further consideration by Council.

PETRO BEACH PARKING

With the completion of the renovations to Petro Beach, public parking is no longer being offered with the exception of 2 stalls for handicapped access. These stalls will be relocated to the entrance adjacent Jarvis Bay Drive.

CURBSTOP REPLACEMENT

During the fall of 2025 a resident had tampered with a curbstop valve during repairs on a private septic tank without approval from Administration. Upon completion of the work the valve would not reopen. Council has directed administration to contract the work to replace a broken curbstop valve as per bylaw #69-97
